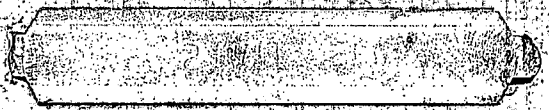

1. In accordance with references (a) and (b), LT C. R. Jones, MSC, USNR and HMI L. Larson, USN of the Naval Energy and Environmental Support Activity, Radiological Affairs Support Office conducted a technical assistance visit at the Naval Air Station, Agana, Guam during the period 7-8 August 1980. The purpose of the visit was to review radiation safety covering radioactive materials and machines which produce ionizing radiation; to review implementation of the recommendations from reference (c); and to provide assistance in maintaining a unified radiation safety program.
2. Findings of the visit and recommendations to improve the radiological safety program are provided in enclosure (1).
