We have received your memo dated 17 July 2007 requesting termination of the subject permit. Upon review, we have concluded that all permitted radioactive materials have been removed from your facility, and residual radioactive material attributable to permitted activities does not exceed current Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) criteria. It is our understanding that all material on-hand has been transferred to Andersen AFB Guam, Permit No. GU-00300-00/00AFP.

Based on this information no further remediation or actions, with respect to NRC regulated material, is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and the subject permit has been TERMINATED effective this date. Attached is the final permit for your files, permit No. KO-30235-02/02AFP.
