SUBJECT: Authorization to Bring and Store Radioactive Material (RAM) on Andersen AFB

1. This memorandum is to inform you that your request to bring and store the RAM, under U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission License Number 04-29431-01, onto Andersen AFB for radiography support as part of project N62742-10-D-1312-JQ01 (*FY10 MILCON P101 Increment 1 & P101A Increment 2, North Ramp Parking*) is approved from the date of this memorandum through 30 November 2013 and subject to the conditions below:

- a. Kleinfelder, Inc. ensures the safety of all personnel to include general public from overexposure to radiation as a result of use/misuse or storage of RAM-containing equipment.
- b. Kleinfelder, Inc. must follow all requirements of your RAM License.
- c. Kleinfelder must store RAM-containing equipment in a locked cabinet inside the Kleinfelder Conex, which is also to remain locked, when equipment is not in use.
- d. Kleinfelder, Inc. is to bear all liability and fully responsible for any loss, theft, mishaps, or misuse of the RAM and any associated costs.

2. The Bioenvironmental Engineering office may conduct periodic inspections of your Radiation Safety procedures, and we reserve the right to suspend operations believed to be unsafe.
